Course Description

F0256 "Safety for Hazardous Materials Incidents." This two-day scenario-based course will provide the students with the knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to assess risks to minimize the impact of harm at hazardous materials/weapons of mass destruction and/or active shooter/hostile event incidents. This course will utilize the risk-based response model to ensure the health and safety for responders. The students' knowledge of the subject is evaluated through activities and graded scenarios.

Selection Criteria

Personnel who may be called upon to assume the duties of the Safety Officer at a hazardous materials incident as described in 29CFR1910.120. This selection criteria is for Training Officers, Chief Officers, Company Officers, and Regular Acting Officer.
