COURSE DESCRIPTION

This course introduces instructional concepts and prepares the instructor candidate for meeting the challenges, tasks, and responsibilities of teaching fire and emergency services training programs. Training managers and supervisors will find the course text useful in the planning of activities such as organizing, budgeting, and conducting training programs. The text, ***Fire and Emergency Services Instructor***, also addresses safety issues and legal concerns, psychology of learning, practical training evolutions, testing and evaluation, and instructional media, technology and critical topics for both the instructor and the organization.

SELECTION CRITERIA

The curriculum for this course meets the requirements of NFPA 1041, Standard for Fire Service Instructor Professional Qualifications, and provides information for all phases of the instruction process. This course describes how to prepare to teach a lesson plan, how to plan a course, and how to manage a training program.
